Biography

Subsequently, he served on destroyers in the Atlantic fleet while on active duty and while in the active Reserves. He attained the rank of lieutenant commander.

He is a member of the Navy League of the United States, and is the judge advocate for the Savannah Council. He is a member of the Military Order of World Wars and serves as the adjutant for the Savannah Chapter. Robb coached youth soccer for 16 years and was a board member of the Coastal Georgia Soccer Association.
